



From Editor

Submission process is over for our 2nd Special Issue which was thought to make a contribution to one of the main objectives of Education and Science that concerns raising the cooperation between academic studies and school practices. We would like to express our special thanks to the authors and the followers of our journal for their intensive attention to Education and Science,-Scale Development Special Issue in which original studies, promoting the development of classroom and school practices and educational activities, are given place.

As of the April 2014 Issue, by courtesy of publishing the manuscripts both in Turkish and English, not only the average number of our followers from abroad but the numbers of international submissions are on rise. The point we arrived at is gratifying by becoming a recognised and widely-followed journal from different countries and universities so far.

With the purpose of facilitating the access to online articles published in Education and Science, Digital Object Identifier (DOI) system has been carried into practice. For each manuscript accepted for publication, there will be a DOI number assigned and shared in our system. For the following issue, by assigning DOI numbers to the accepted articles, access will be increased for the authors and followers of our Journal. In addition, with the intention of enhancing the legibility of our Journal, typesetting and web page has been redesigned.

Reviewing and accepting new submissions to our Journal within a reasonable time, agreed across the scientific journalism, is of great importance and priority. With the objective to accomplish this, we have been working devotedly with vigorous efforts to finalize the reviews of the submitted manuscripts in our system. We would like to thank our associate editors and reviewers for their support and precisions during the process. As we announced to our writers, in the sequel of the finalization of hard efforts spent for the submitted manuscripts in our system, Education and Science will do the honours to set a precedent model in terms of objective and meticulous review with a reasonable time.

In the year of 2014, we would like to organize two workshops on how journalism is considered at the national and international levels. The first of these workshops, details of which will be specified in a short span of time, will be held in October and focusing on the changes and the innovations observed in Turkey and the world, implementations promoting standardization and the problems encountered. The following workshop will be held in December under the aegis of a prominent scientific institution. Dialogues with institutions, analysing the tendencies and contents, and providing editorial trainings, are in progress and further information will be announced in a short period.

In order to lend assistance to the authors who are interested in our announcement regarding January 2015 Meta-Analysis and Content-Analysis Special Issue, two articles will be published in July 2014 Issue. On behalf of avoiding possible submission and content errors, and announcing the expectations in advance, we hope that these two studies will make contribution to the authors. On this opportunity, we would like to thank to our associate editors who prepared these studies and all other associate editors, our authors, followers, Turkish National Association and TEDMEM family.
